

# **Rite of the Celebration of the Ka**

Society of Elder Faiths, Samhain 2024

To seated participants, the Visualization of the Ka meditation is presented. Wabu then asperge the celebrants with water, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**The doors of the sky are opened.  
The doors of the firmament are thrown open  
for the Noble Ones.  
You are bathed in the Stream of Nun.  
You are cleansed in the waters  
of Life and Good Fortune.  
You are pure in this your name,  
Stone of Righteousness.**

Wabu cense the celebrants, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**Beloved Kau, we bring to you the Eye of Heru,  
that it may cleanse you.  
We provide your face with the Wadjet,  
that you may be pure.**

Wabu anoint the brows of the celebrants with oil, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**Behold, we bring you the Great Left Eye.  
Accept It from us, whole and intact.  
Ascend for It, in this It's name, Ornament of the God.  
Delight in it, in this It's name, Willow.  
Gleam with it among the Natjiru,  
in this It's name She Who Flames.  
By joyful by means of It, for Ernutet loves you.**

Wabu present celebrants with linen napkins, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**May you wake in peace.**

**May Tait wake in peace.**

**May Taitet wake in peace.**

**May the Wadjet of Dep awake in peace.**

**May the Wadjet of the Mansions of the Crown  
awake in peace.**

**May you be embraced by Them.**

**May you dwell at the head of the Spirits,  
favored by the Foremost of the Westerners.**

Wabu cense the celebrants, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**The essence of the Wedjat diffuses over you.**

**Take it to yourself, that you may be strong  
before the Spirits, powerful before the Natjiru.**

Water is given to the celebrants or water is poured into a basin before the celebrants, as the Kheri Heb repeats:

**Take the Efflux which issued forth from the Great God,  
that your Akh my manifest,  
that your Sekhem may be upon you.**

**Gather then your bones. Assemble your members.  
Stand upon your feet. Walk upon the worlds.**

The Kheri Heb extends the Sekhem wand five times over the bread and beer, and other food if present, saying:

**Pure! Pure! Pure! Pure!**

**Purified are these offerings for Wsr, the Lord of Kau,  
and those who are in His Train.**

Wabu offer bread and beer to the celebrants, as the Lector repeats:

**May you partake of bread. May you partake of beer.  
May you partake of all good things,  
from the altar of the Lord of Eternity.**

If a feast has been prepared, all may partake.
